Overview **Bronze Award**

- For year 9 and above
- Made up of 4 sections
- It's important to choose activities from the beginning
 - You may be doing lots of your DofE already!



Volunteering	Physical	Skills	Expedition
3 months	3 months	3 months	Train, Plan & complete a 2 day, 1 night expedition

*All participants must undertake a **further** 3 months in the Volunteering, Physical or Skills section.*

Volunteering	Physical	Skills	Expedition
6 months	A section for 6 months A section for 3 months		Train, Plan & complete a 3 day, 2 night expedition

*Direct entrants must undertake a **further** 6 months in the Volunteering or the **longer** of the Physical or Skills sections.*

Volunteering	Physical	Skills	Expedition	Residential
12 months	A for section 12 months A section for 6 months		Train, Plan & Complete a: 4 day, 3 night expedition	Undertake a shared activity in a residential setting away from home for 5 days and 4 nights

*Direct entrants must undertake a **further** 6 months in either the Volunteering or the **longer** of the Physical or Skills section.*

Volunteering

Aim: *To inspire young people to make a difference within their communities or to an individual's life and develop compassion by giving service to others.*

- Helping people
 - Community action and raising awareness
 - Coaching, teaching and leadership
 - Working with the environment or animals
- Helping a charity or community organisation



Physical

Aim: *To inspire young people to achieve greater physical fitness and a healthy lifestyle through participation and improvement in physical activity.*

- Team sports
- Individual sports

- Fitness
- Extreme sports
- Martial arts



Skill

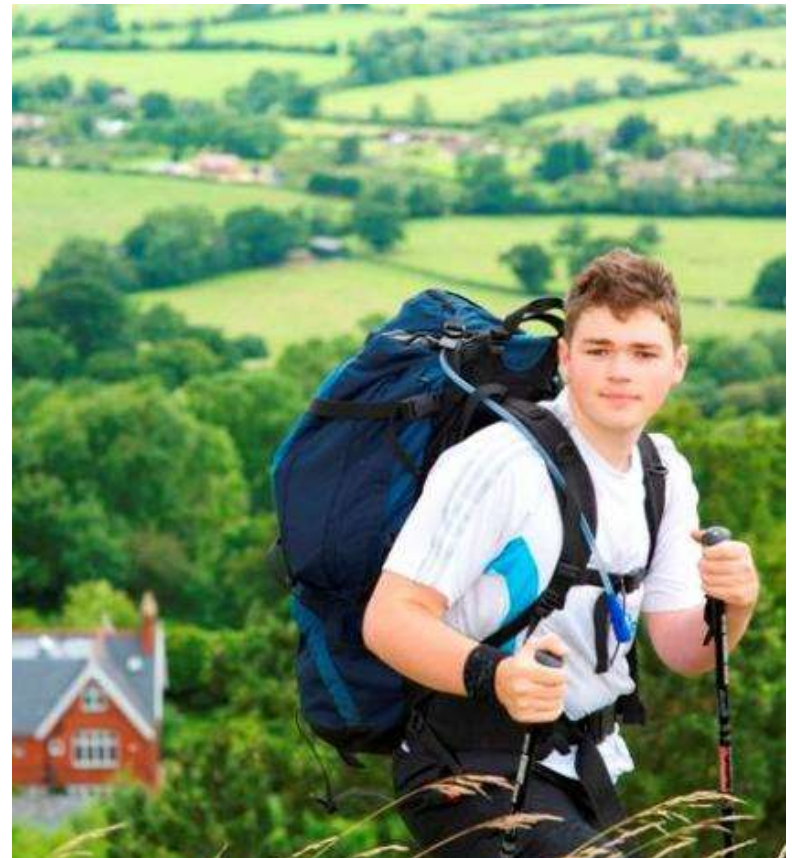
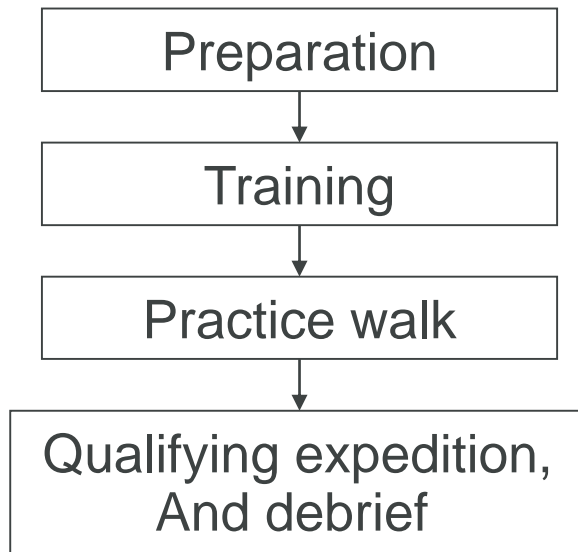
Aim: *To inspire young people to develop practical and social skills and personal interests.*

- Creative arts
- Performance arts
- Science and technology

Expedition

Aim: *To inspire young people to develop initiative and a sense of adventure and discovery, by planning, training for and completing an adventurous journey as part of a team.*



Changes to Bronze Expedition



The bronze level expedition section is currently undergoing a facelift.

“We wanted to see if varying any of the 20 conditions improved the number of participants starting and completing their Expedition section and therefore their whole programme, without affecting the quality of their experience” (DofE 2018)



What does it cost?



Bronze total cost

£211

This is broken into 3 sections:

- **£21** direct to the DofE Charity This includes the DofE welcome pack and enrolment and certification
- **£30** administration and sectional support, online on the edofe record system and support in completion of volunteering, physical and skill.
- **2018 loyalty price £160** training package from C I Adventures
(£180 full price)

What does it cost?



Bronze

Expedition package Section

What is included in the price:

- 2 full days training
- 2 full days Remote supervision
(assessed expedition)
- Training Day Food Samples
(packed lunch not included)
 - Hire/Loan of Tent/Stove
- Gas (fuel) Assessed Expeditions

What is NOT included in the price:

- Food for the Expeditions
 - Hire of personal kit
(examples on letter)
 - Transport
- Campsite / accommodation fees

Bronze

Our expedition package includes:

- 1 day of training workshops.
- 1 day accompanied training day.
- 2 day Assessed expedition



What does it cost Silver?



Total £280 or *£380 Direct

- **£21** direct to the DofE Charity This includes the DofE welcome pack and enrolment and certification
- **£30** administration and sectional support, online on the edofe record system and support in completion of volunteering, physical and skill.
- **£229** expedition training package from C I Adventures
- ***£100** additional payment for Direct entrants to ensure that they have training to bring them to the level other participants who have worked on Bronze level.

Expedition Sessions!



Silver

Our expedition package includes:

- 3 planning sessions (after school)
- 1 Training Day walk locally at Hardcastle Craggs
- Practice expedition 3 Days
(1 instructor led training day and 2 expedition Days)
- Assessed expedition 3 Days

* The location of the expedition is chosen by the participants, typically the Yorkshire Dales or Peak District



What does it cost Gold UK?



Total £350 or *£450 Direct

- **£28** direct to the DofE Charity This includes the DofE welcome pack and enrolment and certification
- **£42** administration and sectional support, online on the edofe record system and support in completion of volunteering, physical and skill.
- **£280** expedition training package from C I Adventures
- ***£100** additional payment for Direct entrants to ensure that they have training to bring them to the level other participants who have worked on Bronze level.

Expedition Sessions!



Gold

Our expedition package includes:

- 3 planning sessions (after school)
- Training Day locally at Hardcastle Craggs
- Practice expedition 4 Days
(1 instructor led training day and 3 expedition Days)
- Assessed expedition (4 Days)

*The location of the expeditions will be chosen by the participants, typically The Lakes District, Wales, Scotland or North York Moors



Additional Silver and Gold Direct Training

- 1 day of training workshops, navigating, tents, lightweight food, stoves and their safe use, personal equipment choice, basic first aid and group safety, countryside code, risk assessment
- 1 day accompanied training day walk in expedition teams, of a similar distance and terrain to that to be carried out in the assessed expedition promoting teamwork and the groups fitness.

Silver and Gold

What is included in the expedition price:

- 3 Planning sessions
- 2 full days training with a qualified expedition supervisor
- 5/7 full days Remote supervision for the practice assessed expedition
- Hire/Loan of Tent/Stove
 - Gas (fuel) Assessed Expeditions

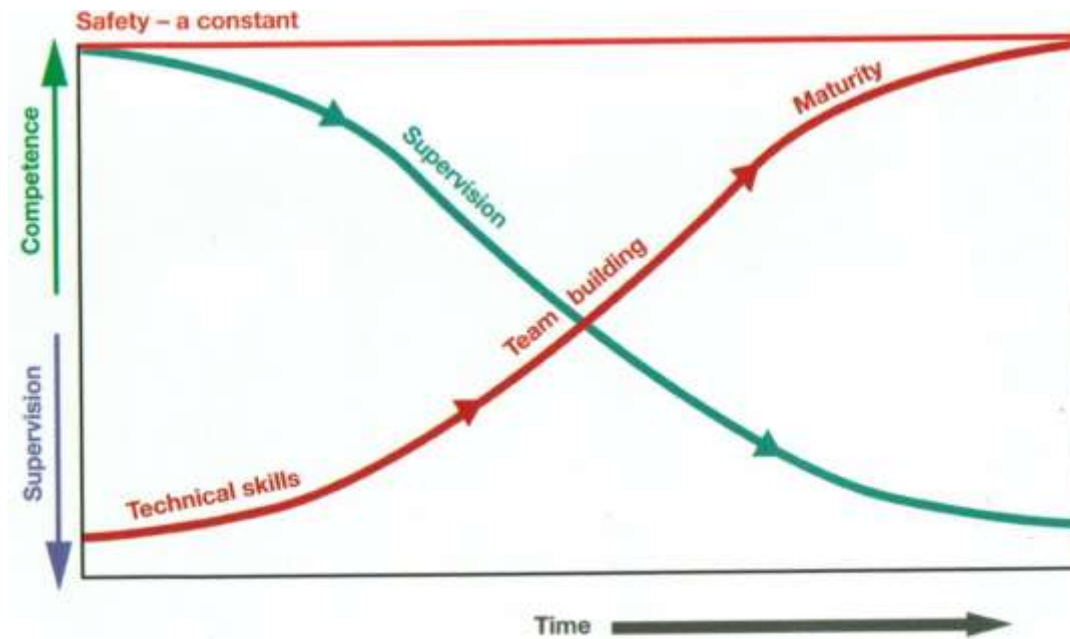
What is NOT included in the price:

- Hire of personal equipment
- Transport to the start and end point
- Campsite fees per night (£8-10 per person per night) or accommodation fees

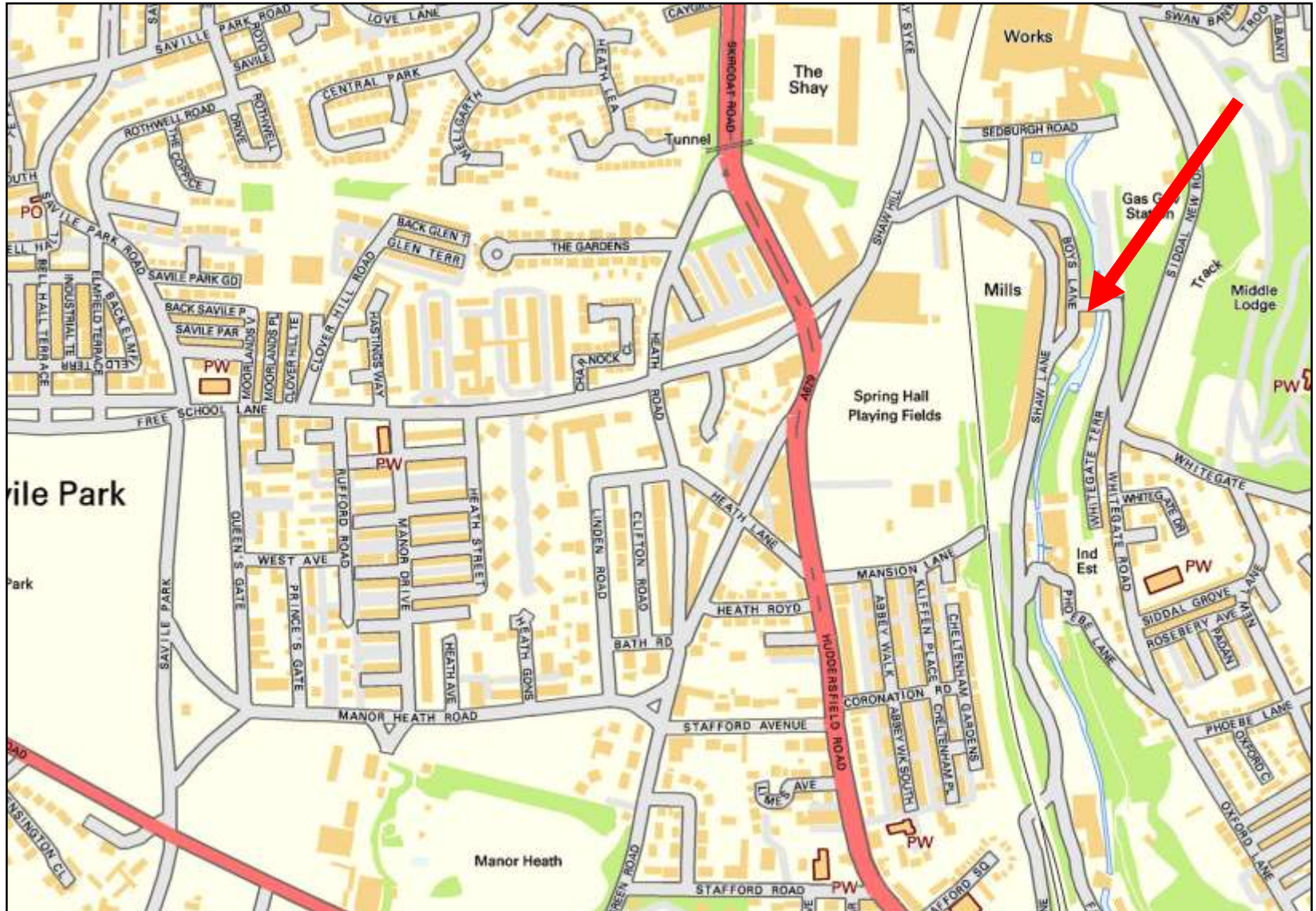
