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Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you and your family are well and enjoying the spell of hot weather. You will be aware the government has announced further relaxation of lock down measures; however, the guidance for secondary schools has not changed. I received confirmation from the Department for Education yesterday that they will publish over 'the coming weeks' further information and guidance to help schools prepare for a full return in September and, in the meantime, schools' current arrangements for this term i.e. Year 10, Year 12 and children of keyworkers should continue.

This means, unfortunately, we do not expect to be able to welcome back our students from Years 7-9 who will continue to learn remotely for the remainder of this term. We are disappointed with this situation of course, as I know many of you will be.

For Year 12 and Year 10 students we will continue with our current model and measures previously advised to parents (please see below).

We will of course continue to update you all as the situation evolves over the next few weeks. Your children are truly remarkable and we really cannot wait to welcome them all back to school just as soon as it is possible. In the meantime, can I thank you all again for your continuing support of the school and for your children during this difficult time.

We have very much enjoyed seeing so many students in school these last two weeks. All of our attendees have shown themselves to be mature and sensible about the arrangements, if maybe a little bemused at first! It has been a delight to see smiling faces, excitement about seeing friends (albeit at a bit of a distance), and keenness to learn. If your child has been unable to attend, they should have received comparable work from their teachers and, please be assured, they are still every bit as important to us.

For those able to attend, these are the arrangements for the next 3 weeks.

w/c 29 June Y10 invited to attend – full arrangements have already been advised to parents.

w/c 6 July Y12 invited to attend for a second session with each of their A level teachers.
The timetable will be the same as for the first Y12 week.

w/c 13 July Y10 invited to attend for second sessions focused on English and Maths.
