Dear Parent/Carer,

I write with a brief update with regard to welcoming all students back into school from September, and to remind parents of Y12 and Y10 about arrangements for the next two weeks in July.

Yesterday we received the Department for Education guidance for schools which we are currently working through. For information, I include the guidance here:

We are very pleased that all our young people will be back with us, but it is clear that the school experience will be very different to normal.

There are significant implications and challenges within the DfE guidance for the day to day organisation of the school and you will appreciate that it will take us some time to work through every aspect of our provision. I ask you to be patient while we do this and to not contact us with queries unless the matter is urgent. I intend to update you again next week; at which time I hope to be able to answer many of the questions you will understandably have.

Please be assured, our principles as we design arrangements for next year will be:

- to ensure the health and safety of our young people and staff,
- to look after your child's emotional health and well-being as we support them to settle back into school life,
- to ensure high quality education, including where children cannot attend,
- to mitigate the personal and educational impact on your child of both lock-down and the situation in the Autumn.

Working alongside our parents and carers will be very important as we all navigate the coming school year. I would like to thank you for your patience and support at this uncertain time.
