Dear Parent/Guardian

We wrote to you last month about the importance of safe and considerate parking around the school grounds when dropping off or collecting your child/ren.

We continue to field complaints, not just from local residents but also other parents and the general public about the disregard that some parents have when parking near school. We appreciate that there will be congestion on local roads at the start and end of the school day, however, we do need to make sure that we are not compromising the safety of anyone including our students. We have had reports this week of cars being parked on curbs and across the lines by the zebra crossing, which really cannot be justified.

I would like to remind you that you should not park on the double yellow lines at the rear and side of the school or on zig-zags. Please also avoid, if possible, parking directly opposite the school buses on Free School Lane because this encourages children to try to cross the road in between the parked buses and other cars. If your child needs to cross Free School Lane to meet you, please encourage him/her to use the zebra crossing.

You may need to park a bit further away from school but this will improve the safety for all of our children and will relieve congestion in the immediate vicinity of school, keeping it safer for everyone.
