

# Crossley Heath School

## Four Day Paris 16 – 19 June 2025

### Day One : Monday 16 June

Depart school on executive coach at 02.00. DVD and toilet facilities on board.

**DFDS ferry** crossing to Calais with breakfast on board (voucher £10) at 10.40

Arrival in Calais at 13.10 and onward journey to a **small chocolate factory**

Onward journey to Paris and arrival at our hotel at approximately 19.00.

Evening meal at our accommodation.

### Day Two : Tuesday 17 June

Breakfast at 08.30 and departure for **Versailles** at 09.30 for a **work study** at the market (**pland role play exercises**).

After lunch, there will be a visit to the **Château of Versailles** and the grounds at 13.30. This is a magnificent château and previous groups have been very interested in the stories which unfold here.

Supper at **Crêperie Les Deux Portes** in Versailles at 17.00 – 18.30 and transfer to Paris for an evening ascent to the second floor of the **Eiffel Tower**.

Finally, there will be a short tour of **Paris by night**, visiting the main areas for the pupils to see the lights and enjoy the atmosphere. Return to the hotel at approximately 22.00.

### Day Three : Wednesday 18 June

Breakfast at 08.00 and departure at 09.00 for the **Sacré Coeur**. In addition, the group will walk to the **Place du Tertre**, where artists at work can be seen. Pupils may even have their portrait painted (10.30 – 12.30)

We will be then able to spend time at the foot of the **Arc de Triomphe**, gaining a fantastic view of the longest avenue in the world before an afternoon tour of the **Orangerie** and a talk on the Impressionist painter Monet (15.00/15.30)

Onwards to a visit (time permitting) at **Les Invalides** before supper at Flunch Restaurant (Beaubourg) 18.00 – 19.00

Evening cruise along the Seine in a **Bateau Mouche** viewing several famous monuments, including **Notre Dame**.

Return to the hotel approx 21.30

## **Day Four : Thursday 19 June**

Breakfast and departure at 09.00 for **Vimy Ridge** - the site of a First World War battlefield, pupils will visit underground tunnels, trenches and No Mans Land.

Departure for Calais, arriving 14.30 and picnic lunch. Ferry from Calais arriving Dover with supper on board (voucher £10) and arrival back at school 23.00.
