

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR BERLIN TRIP 2025

- On the coach, sit facing the front at all times. Wear your seatbelt when the coach is moving.
- Stay seated until you are given permission to leave the coach.
- Wait close to the coach after getting off.
- Listen carefully to all safety instructions on the plane.
- Sit on your allocated seat on the plane.
- Obey all instructions given by Crossley Heath staff. Listen carefully and in silence to all announcements.
- During excursions make sure you are in groups of at least three.
- Make sure you know where and when to meet back with the rest of the group.
- Be punctual at all times.
- Use proper crossings when crossing busy roads.
- Remember the traffic drives on the right in Germany, so look LEFT first when crossing roads.
- Watch out for traffic when crossing car parks.
- Do not get into any private vehicle.
- Do not get into any vehicle if you suspect that the driver is under the influence of an intoxicating substance.
- If you use the internet whilst abroad, do not visit any inappropriate websites.
- Be polite and courteous at all times.
- Do not behave in a dangerous or rowdy manner. No pushing, running, shouting, singing, chanting or swearing.
- You must not smoke, vape, drink alcohol or take drugs.
- Do not take part in any hazardous activities, such as skiing, skateboarding, climbing, cycling or any water sports.
- Do not paddle or swim in lakes, streams or the sea.
- Do not go near dangerous natural features, such as rocks, cliffs or quarries.
- Eat sensibly. Do not eat excessively between meals.
- Look after your money and valuables.
- Do not buy goods from unauthorised traders.
- Do not speak to strangers unnecessarily.
- Do not mess around with sharp objects.
- If it is hot, wear sun cream, sunglasses and a hat.
- Take all medication as it is prescribed.
- Do not use electrical equipment in bathrooms.
- Do not use matches/lighters and do not start any fires.
- Dispose of all litter properly.
- THINK about safety at all times during the trip.
