House Music Final 2025 – Thursday 3 July

We are very excited to write to you regarding the House Music Final. It promises to be a really exciting end to the academic year with some excellent performances planned.

The heats for all solo and ensemble performers will be happening in school on Tuesday 1 July. If your child is involved in this, they will receive a timetable of when to come for the heats and they will be informed by email at the end of the school day if they have been successful in getting through to the final. If they do make it through to the final, they will also be informed whether they will be scheduled to perform in the first or second half of the evening.

The Final will begin at 5pm on Thursday 3 July (with doors opening at 4:45pm) and is likely to finish around 7:15pm. All are invited, whether performing or simply supporting those who are. Entrance is free but donations are welcome and this will go towards equipment for future events. If you are planning on attending, I would strongly encourage you to come for the whole event, but if you know that your child is performing in the second half, and you want to come specifically for that, I would suggest that you arrive at around 6:00pm. Student performers must sign in at the trestle tables in the foyer. Performers for the first half must sign in by 4:50pm and for the second half by 5:50pm at the latest. Those involved in the House Choir performances will be informed in advance whether they are scheduled to be in the first or second half. There is still time to join the House Choirs if your child is interested. Information about upcoming rehearsals is accessible on their House TEAMS page. We really want to encourage as many students to get involved as we can. The evening will finish with our House Open/Final which is a joint performance between sixth form and staff.

There will be refreshments served in the interval, with thanks to the CHPTA, and also a tuck shop available.

Our adjudicators will score all performances and the house with the highest score at the end of the evening will be declared as House Music Champions 2025.

At the end of the evening, it is vital that all performers sign out. Please make the necessary arrangements to collect your child if they are performing and you are not able to be in the audience.
