- Every student is challenged to raise as much money as possible

Just like last year every Form group in our school has been challenged to prepare a fundraising stall for our 'Marketplace' which will take place on the Arena over lunchtime on **Thursday 10th July** and **Friday 11th July**. Last year's stalls included bake sales, craft sales, games, henna art, face painting and so much more. Year 7 and Year 9 will set up their stalls on Thursday 10th July, Year 8 and Year 10 on Friday 11th July, with Year 12 being split between both days. Students are also encouraged to repeat their stall at the PTA's Summer Fete on **Saturday 12th July** to boost their individual fundraising totals.

How can you kindly help?

- Support your child in the planning of their stall, ask what their form is doing
- Give your child some spending money to enjoy the stalls in our Arena Marketplace
- If possible, encourage your child to also run a stall at the PTA Summer Fete on Saturday 12th July

If every form group was able to run just one marketplace stall earning £10 we would raise over £2500.

COLOUR RUN

Back by popular demand! After last year's amazingly successful Colour Run, we're thrilled to be doing it all again this year! This exciting whole-school afternoon event will see all students and staff getting involved in the fun as we jump, hop, skip or dance our way through a vibrant Colour Run on the Moor. Students will wear their school PE kit for the full day. After a morning of lessons, the entire school will head out in the afternoon to take part. During lunchtime, there'll be extra refreshments on sale from our Sixth Form-run tuck shop - perfect for spectators enjoying the action.

All students will complete a fun run lap of the Moor, choosing from two route options:

Route Option 1 is our traditional Crossley Heath Cross Country route around the tree line of the moor. This is the 'clean route' and will not have any colour powders. Students may even wish to complete their lap wearing house colours or even in fancy dress!

COLOUR RUN

Route Option 2 is the 'Colour Run' where students encounter a number of 'colour stations' where they will be covered in food grade non-toxic vegetable starch powders. To enter the colour run:

- **Bronze level = £6**

This will include colourful sunglasses

- **Silver level = £12**

This includes colourful sunglasses and a white t-shirt to keep (and get super messy!)

- **Gold level = £16**

This includes colourful sunglasses, white t-shirt and a neon visor

Please pay for your child's place through Parent Pay, selecting one option only. Any additional sponsorship money can be brought to school in cash in a labelled envelope and deposited before school in the school finance office every day during Fundraising Fortnight. Online payments can be made on the '[Donations](#)' page of our website, please state 'Fundraising Fortnight' and your child's name as the reference.

How can you kindly help? Pay for your child's place on our Colour Run (ideally at Gold level) by Monday 30th June. Encourage your child to collect additional sponsorship money from friends and family, bringing this in as cash, via contactless card payments or on the 'Donations' section of our website during Fundraising Fortnight.

If every student and staff member raised £20 individually e.g. through sponsorship for the colour run or other ideas we would raise nearly £20,000.



COLOUR RUN

To take part in the colour run students must have signed up via Parent Pay by Monday 30th June.

On the day please bring:

- Spare old top/bottoms (to wear on top or underneath PE kit as clean set to travel home – no changing facilities)
- Towel (to sit on when spectating and to clean off after race)
- Spare change of shoes (we recommend running in old/dark coloured trainers)
- Bag to place dusty/dirty clothes/shoes in.
- Bin bag to sit on for their journey home.
- Water bottle & sun screen/hat - appropriate wear for the weather.

Students may also wear swimming goggles and or a facemask if they have particular environmental sensitivities/respiratory issues.

There will be no space available/provision for spectators on the day but we will capture the event and share images/footage on our social media channels.
