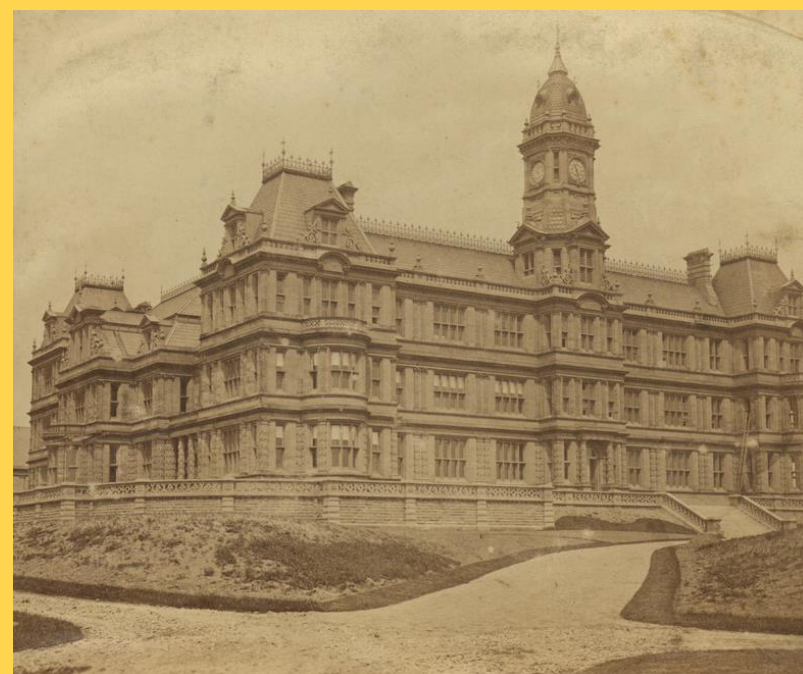

HOW MUCH CAN WE RAISE?



- Imagine if every Crossley Heath student raised just...
- £5 - that equals over £4,500
- £10 - that's over £9,000
- £20 - that's over £18,000
- £30 - that's a whopping £27,000!!

- Raising £10 each would generate almost as much as we raised during the whole of Fundraising Fortnight 2025

- Together, we can achieve something extraordinary!
