Dear Parents,

We are now in the happy position of having travel and accommodation booked through the tour operator for the Battlefields trip from **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> of June to Friday 7<sup>th</sup> of June 2024**. The current take up for the tour is 41 students which means the initial projected cost of £480 will be sufficient. This will allow us to cover the costs not only of the travel, insurance, hotels and food but also of the entry into the museums we visit during the tour. Students will need some Euros for snacks/souvenirs and some sterling for the journey – although we will give students £10 on the Friday evening return trip to cover the cost of a meal at the motorway services.

The balance remaining for the cost of the tour is £380 per student (if you initially just paid the £100 deposit) and we would like this balance to have been paid in full before the end of the Spring term/Easter. Many thanks to those parents who have already paid in full. The tour company requires all balances paid at least 8 weeks prior to departure. All payments for this trip should be paid through the Parent Pay facility. Log on to [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) and click on the Trip Heading.
