




#### Expedition

#### **CI Adventures will:**

#### Residential (Gold Only)

- Undertake a shared activity in a residential setting away from home for 5 days and 4 nights
- This could be experiencing a new fun activity for the participant
- Working for a charity and volunteering your time whilst experiencing something new. It must not be a paid job

#### Examples:

University course taster week, residential cookery course, Outward Bound holiday, exchange student placement, National Trust volunteer weeks, international camp, volunteer support at a junior school residential

#### Overview **Bronze Award**

- For Yr 9 and above
- Made up of 4 sections
- Important to choose activities from beginning
- You may be doing lots towards your DofE already!



#### **Expedition Sessions!**



#### **Bronze**

#### Our expedition package includes:

- 1 day of training workshops; navigating, tents, lightweight food, stoves and their safe use, personal equipment choice, basic first aid and group safety, countryside code, risk assessment
- 1 day accompanied training day walk in expedition teams, of a similar distance and terrain to that to be carried out in the Assessed Expedition; promoting teamwork and group fitness.
  - 2 day Assessed Expedition including an overnight camp and remote supervision.
  - All instruction and group equipment hire such as tents, stoves & gas














#### Remote supervision, what does that mean?



- As training progresses we will reduce supervision giving the participants a chance to be independent
- We will have staff on hand by during the expedition in case of emergency
- All participants are expected to follow a code of conduct for behaviour showing respect for the environment and other members of the public
- Participants are a direct representative of the school











#### Code of Conduct



#### **C I Adventures Camping Code of Conduct**

#### Participants must:

- leave no trace
- be courteous of other campers
- abide by campsite rules, especially curfews
- sleep in their own allocated tent
- be in their own tent by a reasonable time, agreed by your team or supervisor
- not wander around the campsite at night

Please remember you need suitable rest to ensure you are fit to complete your expedition.

Participants must report (either directly, by phone or via campsite staff) to their supervisor if:

- someone is missing from their tent
- someone additional is sleeping in their tent


Once payment has been received on ParentPay a link will be provided. Follow this to the registration form. Please complete your child's details and select the award level.



#### **CI Adventures – DofE Cancellation Policy**



 When an individual enrols for a DofE Award it requires an amount of planning and administration, earmarking equipment, booking employees, securing freelance staff and reserving venues. This process begins some time before any classroom session or expedition, as such this cancellation policy attempts to reflect the work undertaken in the event of a cancellation whilst having regard to the continued support of any client.

#### **Cancellations by the individual**

- Upon enrolment the individual is registered with the eDofE, and administration and group planning commences. Consequently, cancellation after enrolment (completion of the online form) means that the first payment is non-refundable.
- If the individual cancels their participation in the Practice and Assessed Expeditions less than one month before the Practice Expedition is due to take place the full programme fee is still due.
- If the individual cannot attend any scheduled Practice or Assessed Expeditions the full programme fee is due.
- If the Practice Expedition is attended but not the Assessed the full programme fee is still due.

#### **Cancellation by CI Adventures**

In the unlikely event that CI Adventures has to cancel a booking we will attempt to reschedule it to other dates. If this is not possible CI Adventures will refund any monies paid by you over and above the first non-refundable payment. CI Adventures cannot be held responsible for any costs incurred by you resulting from the cancellation.

#### Cancellations outside the control of you or CI Adventures

In the event that your booking is cancelled because of natural disasters, extreme weather or government directive/legislation there may be a cancellation fee to cover costs incurred by CI Adventures which may be, in extraordinary circumstances, up to the full programme cost.
